



Champagne

- Champagne Gaston Dericbourg 'Cuvée de Reserve' Brut NV, France
 Fabulously traditional style with gentle biscuit flavours complemented by deliciously refined,
 grapey fruit flavours. A fantastically quaffable Champagne that is magnificent on its own or
 with canapés at a drinks party.
- Champagne Pannier EV Brut Sélection NV, Château Thierry, Marne, France
 A classic champagne ideal for an aperitif. Its yeasty nose, a well balanced and elegant attack make
 it very easy to drink, the long finish shows how serious the wine is. Champagne Pannier is the
 house champagne of discerning establishments the world over.
- Generous and plentiful strings of tiny bubbles. Powerful aromas of fruits in pastry, stewed apricot with notes of sugared almond. Slight notes of pepper and aniseed. The feel in the mouth is very ample and long, with pastry flavours and ending on a spicy note.
- 4 Champagne Pannier Brut Rosé NV, France
 Brilliant salmon pink colour with a fine stream of minuscule bubbles. A strong aromas of fully ripened red fruits (cherry, raspberry). Fresh and pure flavours with overtones of red fruits and toasted bread. A balanced finish with great length and finesse.
- Champagne Pannier Brut Vintage 2005, France

 A delicious golden colour with a touch of yellow, the bubbles are smooth and fine, which shows how delicate this wine is. There are plenty of peach aromas, with a hint of candied orange and fresh hazelnut. In the mouth it is both round and fruit-filled, yet crisp and elegantly balanced, followed by a fresh finish, with toasty and bread-like flavours.
- Champagne André Roger Grand Cru Vieilles Vignes NV, Äy, France
 The vines, by the way, share a hillside with those that yield grapes for the likes of Cristal and
 Dom Perignon. Aromas are dominated by juicy fruit, such as white peach and stewed lemon.
 Well structured and long on the finish without being heavy.





Prosecco & Alternatives

- Prosecco Frizzante Colli Trevigliani NV, Enrico Bedin, Veneto, Italy

 This is classic frizzante from Enrico Bedin in the Veneto, with a fine spritz and packed full of fresh, ripe, apple and delicate melon flavours and a clean, crisp dry finish.
- Prosecco Spumante, Colli Trevigliani NV, Enrico Bedin, Veneto, Italy

 This wonderfully pretty Prosecco is so beautifully balanced and fresh, with flavours of ripe apple and a very sublte grapiness leading to a really crystal clean finish.
- Prosecco Superiore DOCG Millesimato 2012, Enrico Bedin, Veneto, Italy
 Slightly richer than their two other wines, hints of lively floral notes and elderflower. Beautifully crisp, fresh, lovely, elegant texture and feel and just a bit more length than the regular Spumante.
- 'David' Spumante Rosato NV, Enrico Bedin, Veneto, Italy

 This Spumante Rosato is bursting with fresh, ripe and succulent raspberry, redcurrants and watermelon aromas and flavours, complemented by a dry, mouthwatering finish.
- Cava El Pont de Ferro Brut, Spain
 Wonderfully fresh, lively and light bodied Cava bursting citrus and pear aromas, with a persistent fizziness, a slight peach flavour and a crisp, well balanced finish.
- 6 A. Laurance Brut, Loire Valley, France
 Clean, crisp aromas of fresh granny smith apple, followed by citrus fruits, pear and more granny smith flavours, complemented by a gentle fizz and a lingering sweet fruit driven finish





Whites

- Solano White, Galicia, Spain

 A delicious blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Viura, and Palomino, this is very easy-drinking and full of flavour, with an attractive balance and a clean, crisp finish.
- 2010

 Mas de la Source Réserve Blanc, Pays d'Oc, France
 A fantastic wine composed of 50% Vermintino, 30% Sauvignon Blanc, plus a little
 Muscat and Grenache Blanc The result is aromatic and floral, with some complexity,
 minerality and plenty of body and richness.
- Maison de la Paix Marsanne Viognier, Pays d'Oc, France
 This is a beautiful blend of 60% Marsanne and 40% Viognier. It is a very smooth white with a rich texture and good length.
- 4 Mon Blanc de Domaine Montrose, Pays d'Oc, France
 A beautiful blend of 85% Chardonnay and 15% Vermentino This white is aromatic
 and fresh with gorgeous peachy, tropical fruit notes on the nose and palate.
- 5 Luccio, Tenuta Roveglia, IGT Lombardy, Italy
 A lovely dry crisp blend of Trebbiano and Ugni Blanc with beautifully defined notes
 of citrus fruits and a clean refreshing finish.
- Mâcon-Villages 'Les Charmes', Corton André, France
 A lovely white with an extremely attractive combination of fine texture and ripe
 notes of apple; fresh, clean, unoaked Chardonnay flavours and a refreshing crispness.





Reds

- Solano Red, Galicia, Spain

 A wonderfully approachable blend of Tempranillo and Granacha; spectacularly fresh yet with warming round rich fruit.
- 2 Mas de la Source Réserve, Rouge, Pays d'Oc, France
 A marvellous blend of Grenache, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon Spicy, plummy and
 extremely well balanced with lovely black and red berry flavours and a good length.
- Maison de la Paix Old Vine Carignan, Pays d'Oc, France
 A fabulously luscious spicy wine. The lower yields produced from old vines result in deliciously, full, developed flavours of red berries. An extremely well balanced wine with lovely smooth tannins.
- 4 Château La Croix du Duc, Bordeaux, France
 A classically styled refined claret composed of 90% Merlot ripe and juicy in style,
 with lovely soft tannins and wonderful plummy flavours.
- 5 La Chamiza 'Polo Professional' Reserve Malbec, Argentina 2009

 A fantastically full and rich yet polished Malbec, wonderful blackberry and spicy notes dominate the nose and palate; an elegant yet broad red with a long length.
- Côte du Rhône, Château de Saint Cosme, France

 An extremely impressive Grenache dominated blend with a great depth of spicy
 fruit, fine tannins and a smooth silky texture.
